




DULANEY HIGH SCHOOL'S BOOK OF THE MONTH CLUB

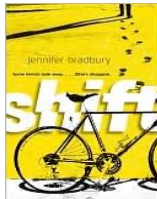
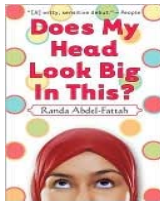
